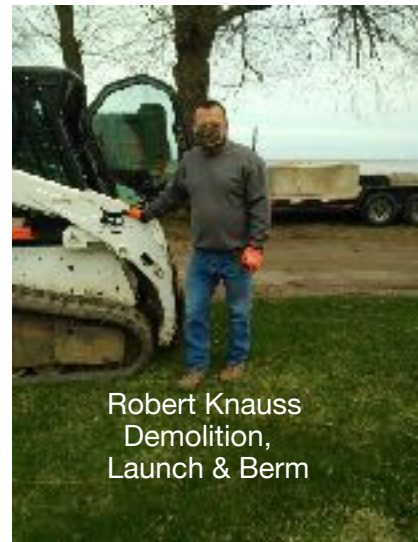

Our contractor is currently working on finishing the boat launch and berm. Once the cement for the launch has been poured it will need to cure for 30 days. We are waiting to hear a date of when it will be poured. The tree stumps and building demolition will be happening within the next week or 2 followed by the foundation work. If you do stop at the club please remember it is a construction site and precautions need to be taken. During this time, to keep our contractors safe please wear a mask and social distance if you are at PMI. This is really important and is one of the conditions allowing our contractors to work at PMI. Please help us keep them safe.

after the stop work order has ended. The foundation, berm and boat launch are all essential to reducing flooding on the property.

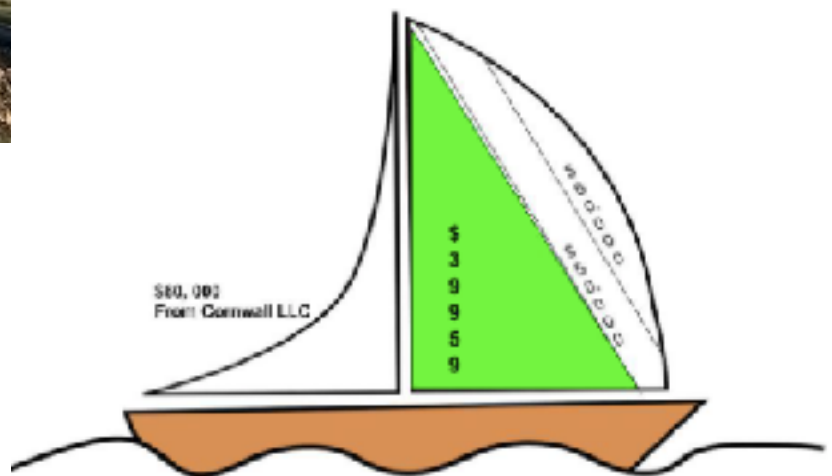
Unfortunately, putting up a new building is not. The building permit process has been started and we have permission to remove the old building and do the foundation for the new building. Once the stop work order has ended the new



building should go up fairly quickly. We are excited that the project is moving forward and we just have to have patience.



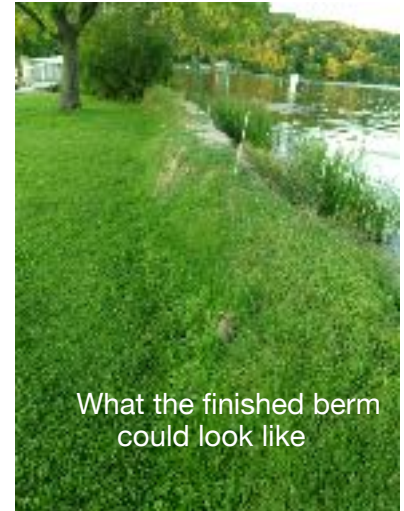
