Welcome to Spring 2022 at PMI!

As usual, the new updated **2022 membership card(s)** will be distributed during the **Spring Clean-up day on April 30th**. If for any reason, you will not be able to pick up your membership card on that day, please send an email, call or text to me so we can make other arrangements..



The **membership card** will have the newly assigned combinations to access the:

- main gate,
- the restrooms and restroom supply closets,
- the waterfront pavilion door,
- the cartwheel and dolly shed,
- the patrol shed, boat ramp
- And your storage shed assignment(s)

PMI Car and Boat stickers will be distributed as needed throughout the season.

In regards to **boat, trailer and gear storage**, we have no current plan to make any changes to your previously assigned shed, drysail or dock wall location(s) unless there is some physical issue such as high / low water levels or shed / dock damage. If you are new to the club and in need of storage I will work with you to find that space.

Shed storage notes:

- Springtime is Shed inventory time! We conduct an inventory to determine if there are boats and / or gear that are no longer being used or are abandoned.
- If you are aware of boats or gear not used or abandoned, please let us know. We'll try to identify the owners and contact them. No longer used or abandoned boats may become available for others to purchase. So, help us with this process.
- Please help by checking your shed space and the spaces above, below and next to your space. Make sure that your boat gear stays within your assigned space.
- Clearing and cleaning-out sheds makes space available for others.
- Please make sure all your SUP, kayaks, canoes, sailboats and trailers have a PMI sticker on it.
- Shed 7 and 8 have very limited space for lasers and laser-like boats. PMI is actively investigating alternatives to increase shed space for laser like boats. Changes may be coming. We will keep you posted!

Landscaping Committee, trees and beach grass report by Deborah Arndt

We're looking forward to another season of providing tender loving care to PMI's beautiful property. Thanks to Gail Koudelka, great strides are being made in planning for installation of several tree saplings where needed, and looking ahead to needed plants and ground covers. In December, American Beach Grass was planted along the north western edge of the lawn to extend a berm for reducing sand and wind erosion, and protect against high water. Young plants are marked, please ensure that you don't walk on these areas of new plantings. Temporary sand fencing will be replaced during the season with lower wind guards to easily step around, which will be removed when beach grass is fully grown later in the season.
