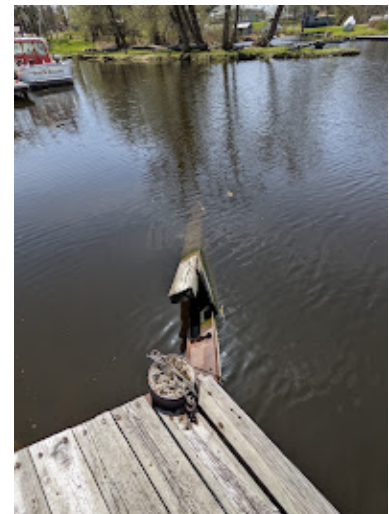


We had nine members attend the Sail Patrol Boat training and we are looking forward to some hands-on training this summer (setting and retrieving racing marks).

Hello everyone. Saturday was certainly a busy day for everyone. It was wonderful to see past members and to welcome our new members.

Membership cards: While most of the members received their membership cards, Some members who attended spring clean up did not pick up their membership cards. All the locks have now been changed so entry to the club premises and to your storage will be quite difficult since you do not have the new lock combinations. There are also many members who could not attend spring clean up. So, I have a plan. If you need

to get your membership cards, please send me an email and I will arrange for you to get your cards. .

Boat storage: I met with many members on Saturday to assign boat storage and provide them with the lock combinations. If you still need your assigned storage slot, please send me an email. For drysail sailboats with trailers...the south lawn is a bit of a mess right now as some monohull sailboats are stuck in the mud. The south lawn drysail area will fluctuate over the next couple of months. If you are bringing your sailboat to park on the lawn please do not block any sailboat. We need to leave a path for the monohulls to be pulled out and launched.

Trailer Storage: This year we have arranged for members to store their trailers off site in a designated location over at PYC. PYC will let us know where we should park our trailers at a later date. We are requesting empty trailers to be stored in this off site location to free up space on our south lawn. There will be exemptions of course. We can figure this out at a later date.

Boat and car stickers: Send me an email with the number of boat and car stickers you need. All sailboats, trailers, kayaks, stand-up paddle boats need to have a sticker. I will make arrangements for you to get these stickers.
