From the Dockmaster, Linda Rohlfing

Please contact me If you still need:

- your membership card and boat / car stickers
- your shed storage assignment and lock combination,
- your Dockwall slip assignment,
- Your drysail location.

Shed Storage: By this time in the season, I hope everyone has the shed storage they have requested and that all is well. If anyone finds there are issues with their shed or they wish to make a change, please send me an email.

Dry Sail lawn:

- PLEASE remember to mow the lawn around your dry sailboat and trailer. It should be done weekly. You should move everything out of your spot and then move back in after you have mowed the lawn. The lawn mower is stored in the patrol shed. There is plenty of gas in the shed so please make sure you refill the mower after each use.
- The **east side row** of boats on the lawn (the row that is close or parallel to the houses) is designated for ACTIVE beach launching boats. Smaller lighter weight beach launch boats will be parked closer to the chain link fence. The heavier larger sailboats like the catamarans will be parked closer to the bathrooms.
- The **south side row** remains primarily for monohull sailboat storage.
- The **Cat Island** organization is in flux due to pooling of water. There is an active plan to remediate the water issue. Most members who have their cats on the island will not need to move. However, the members that have already moved to avoid the water will likely need to move again when the drainage system gets installed. Once the system is in place and working, the cats will move back to their original assigned locations.

Trailer lot: The offsite PYC Hamilton Street trailer lot is available to store our PMI trailers for the Summer Trailer storage. We will need to have as many trailers stored there as possible to keep our lawn open. Please contact me prior to moving your trailer to make sure you park it in the correct location. This area belongs to PYC. We are sharing this location.

And Remember Deb Arndt's **B O A T S** rule:

B for Beach: Boats may be placed overnight on the beach for no more than 24 hours and well back from the shore to allow for maintenance. Keep the beach launching lane clear at all times.

O is for Others. Remember to be considerate of others and their boats. Please don't relocate/ move others' boats without checking with the Dockmaster. Close and lock gates and bathrooms (lights off) if you are the last one leaving the property. Please don't place boats where they impede member access or property maintenance.

A is for Assignment. Place your boat only in your assigned location: either in sheds, 'dry sail' locations on the South Lawn or Cat Island, or Wall dock.

T is for Take the Time to notify the Dockmaster of any changes in your storage needs or location.

S is for Sticker! Remember to sticker all boats and your cars, too. For sheds, place stickers on the end of the boat facing the shed doors.

Clean up as you go along! Please dispose of all trash, bottles/cans, and clean up surfaces/sinks in the food prep area after use. As members, we are all volunteers in keeping our Club sparkling and beautiful. Please help us to keep it that way.

Safety first! Please remember children are not allowed on the channel walkway, docks, or rock walls. Children are not allowed to swim or paddle in the channel. Please do not throw any objects, wood, or rocks into the channel. Children must be supervised at all times on the waterfront.

Fire safety, too! Please supervise all children near the fire pits: no horseplay with firewood, lighting fires, or playing in or adjacent to fire pits when in use.

Sign guests in. Remember to sign in your guests with the Duty Officer.
