Speaking of safe sailing, I collected a list of about twenty members who expressed interest in purchasing a marine radio. I have approached two vendors requesting a discount on a high quantity purchase. West Marine offered a 10% discount which would bring the cost to about \$90 plus tax per radio. TheGPSstore.com has the radio listed for \$88 plus tax per unit on their website, but would not offer any further discounts. West Marine has a brick and mortar store location in Irondequoit on East Ridge Road. The GPS Store is located in North Carolina, but has an A+ BBB rating. I believe that having the local store is worth the extra \$2 if we encounter any problems, however I am willing to listen to any differing opinions. I will be contacting those who expressed interest to get a commitment and begin collecting the funds. Anyone else who is interested is encouraged to contact me. We do have some time since West Marine will be replenishing their stock in early June.

The model we are looking into is the Standard Horizon HX210. This model is very popular with our board sailors. I have included links to the radio for both West Marine and The GPS Store.

Lots happening on the grounds of PMI - The power outlets are energized in the South part of the property. One is by the dock on the concrete structure and one is on the South light pole. Both are GFCI for your safety, so if it trips you can reset it, but if it keeps tripping, there are a couple of things you can do. Check your extension cord for shorts, check your power tool for shorts or faults. Also, if you are stringing more than one extension cord together, make sure the mating ends are not sitting on the ground. Put a mat, bucket, or something underneath to prevent the GFI from tripping.

Drainage work is beginning on the Hobie Island, aka Lake Hobie. New playground equipment has been donated by the Dougherty family and will be installed soon. Can't wait to see it up and the kids enjoying it.

Volunteers needed. This Friday night - 4 able bodied people to move the deck from the North side of the bath house across the driveway and lean up against the small sail boat shed. It will be put back after the "Big Dig" ie. Hobie Island Drain project — then relax and enjoy **Friday Happy-ness Time**
