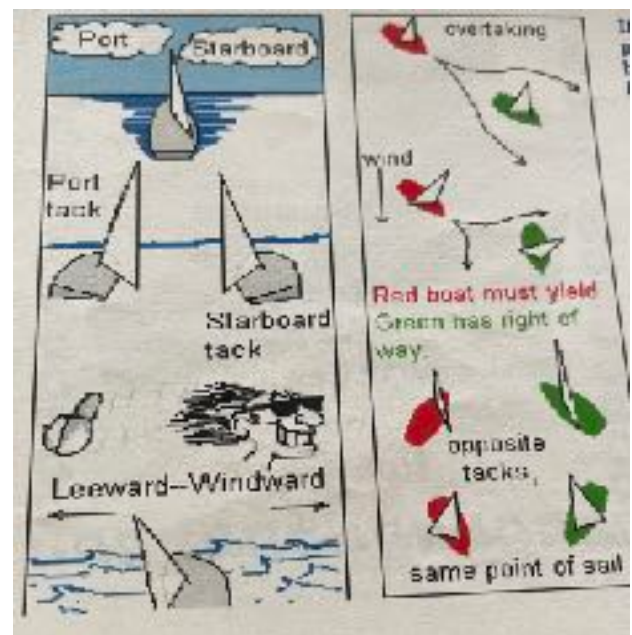

The weather station gives data on temperature, pressure, humidity, lightning strikes, wind speed and direction as well as a bunch of other parameters. The best thing is you can access the weather station's data on line at ambientweather.net ! Directions on how to access the web site is at the end of this Mainsheet. **Please, do not unplug or move the base station! We lose our online access to the weather data if we move or unplug the unit.**

You can access the PMI weather station on your phone by downloading the ambient weather app from the apple or Google play store

Our club is now in full swing as the summer starts. Here are few points to remember:

Parking: I ask everyone to be considerate about parking your cars so as not to block sailboats maneuvering to and from the beach or boat launch.

PMI Stickers: Please make sure you put PMI stickers on your boat(s), trailer(s) and car(s). If you need additional stickers...send me an email for how many you need.

Trailer Storage: Unfortunately, the off site trailer storage lot is not yet available due to construction by the town.

Drysail lawn care: Please maintain the lawn around your drysail area at least bimonthly. The Lawn mower is available in the patrol shed. Please use the red gas tank with non-ethanol gas to refill the lawn mower. If you notice the gas is getting low, please let a board member know so we get it refilled.

** Note: please keep your drysail boat neat and tidy. Keep the land around your boat clear of boat lines and debris, so that our lawn mowing service does not run over anything in the lawn.

Sheds: Be sure that your boat and gear are stored in **your** shed slot and that your gear does not impinge upon another member's storage slot.

Heads up! There are a few shed spaces that have accumulated stuff like fishing poles, inflatable tubes, folding chairs, etc over the years and I cannot find who this stuff belongs to. So there is a plan to clear these spaces out. The items in these spaces will be put out for our general membership to take and repurpose. This will happen periodically throughout the summer season, usually when we have a large social event.

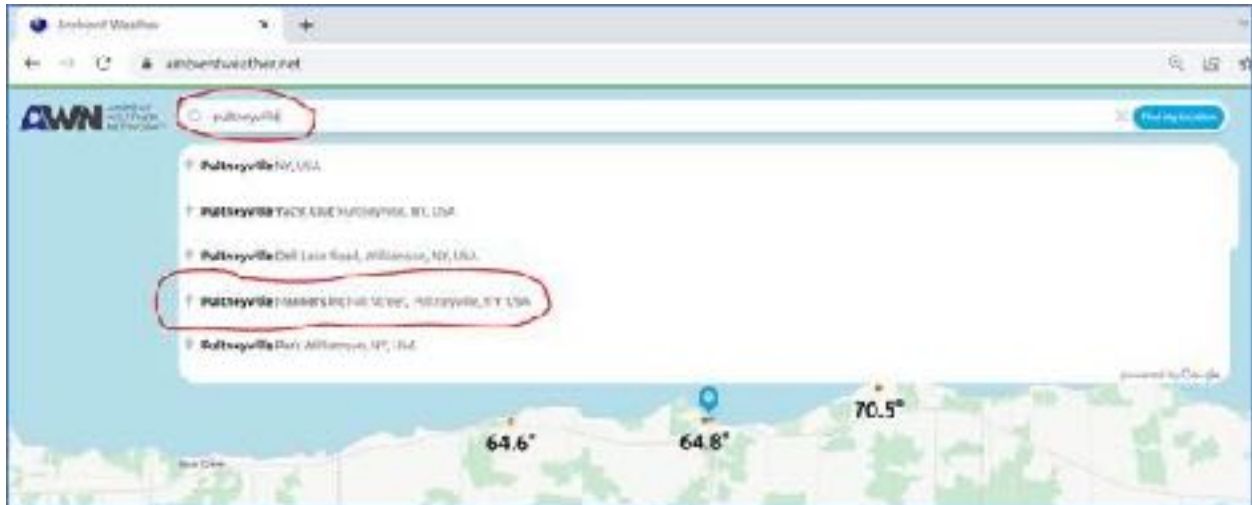

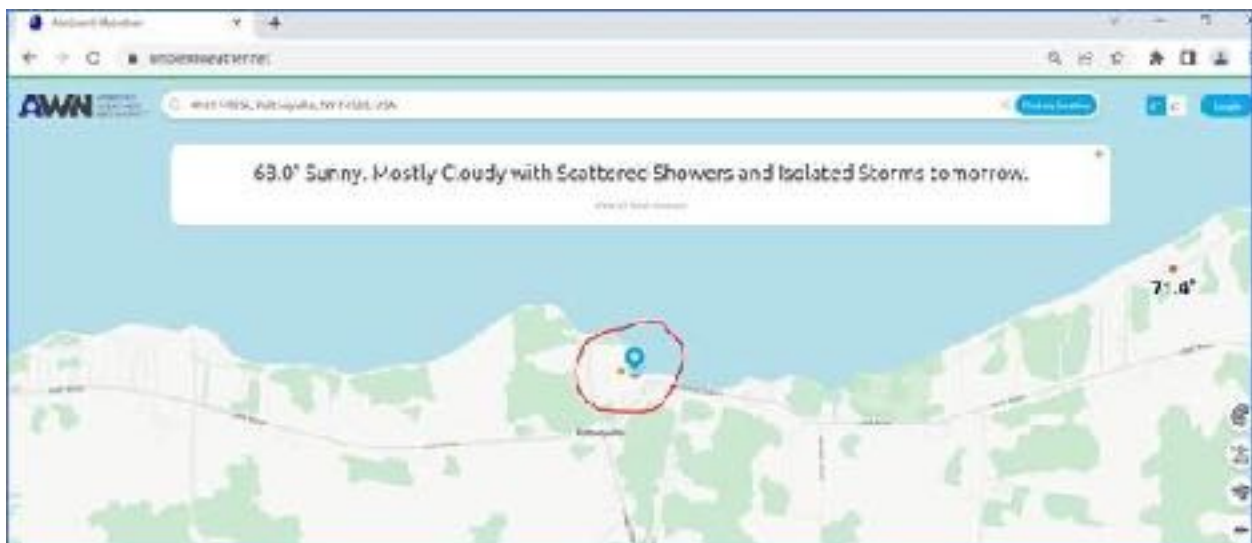


PMI WEATHER STATION WEB ACCESS DIRECTIONS:

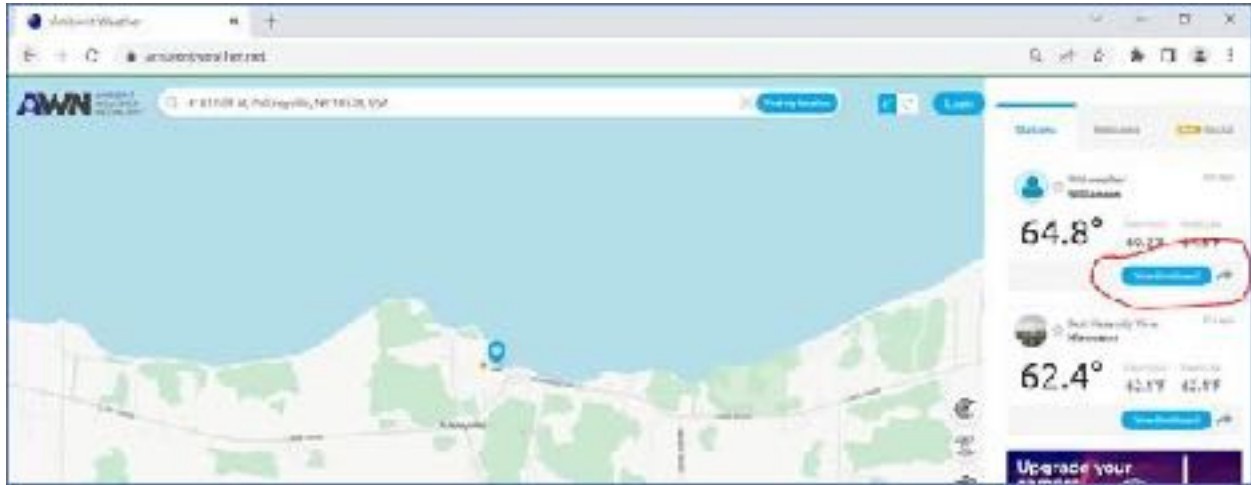
1. Log onto **ambientweather.net**
2. Type **Pultneyville** in the **Find My Location** box



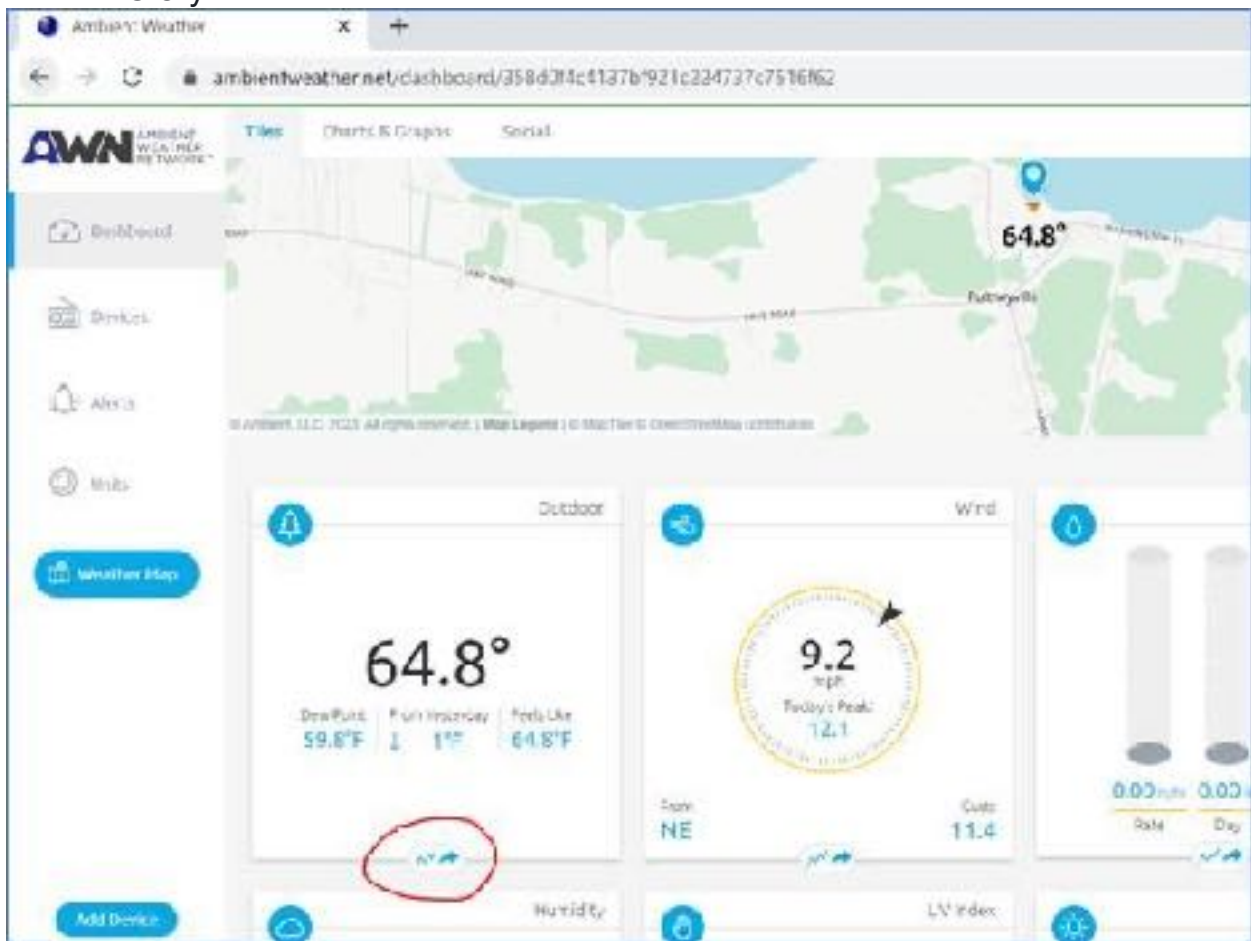
3. Select **Pultneyville Mariners Inc, Mill Street Pultneyville, NY, USA**
4. Click on the location marker

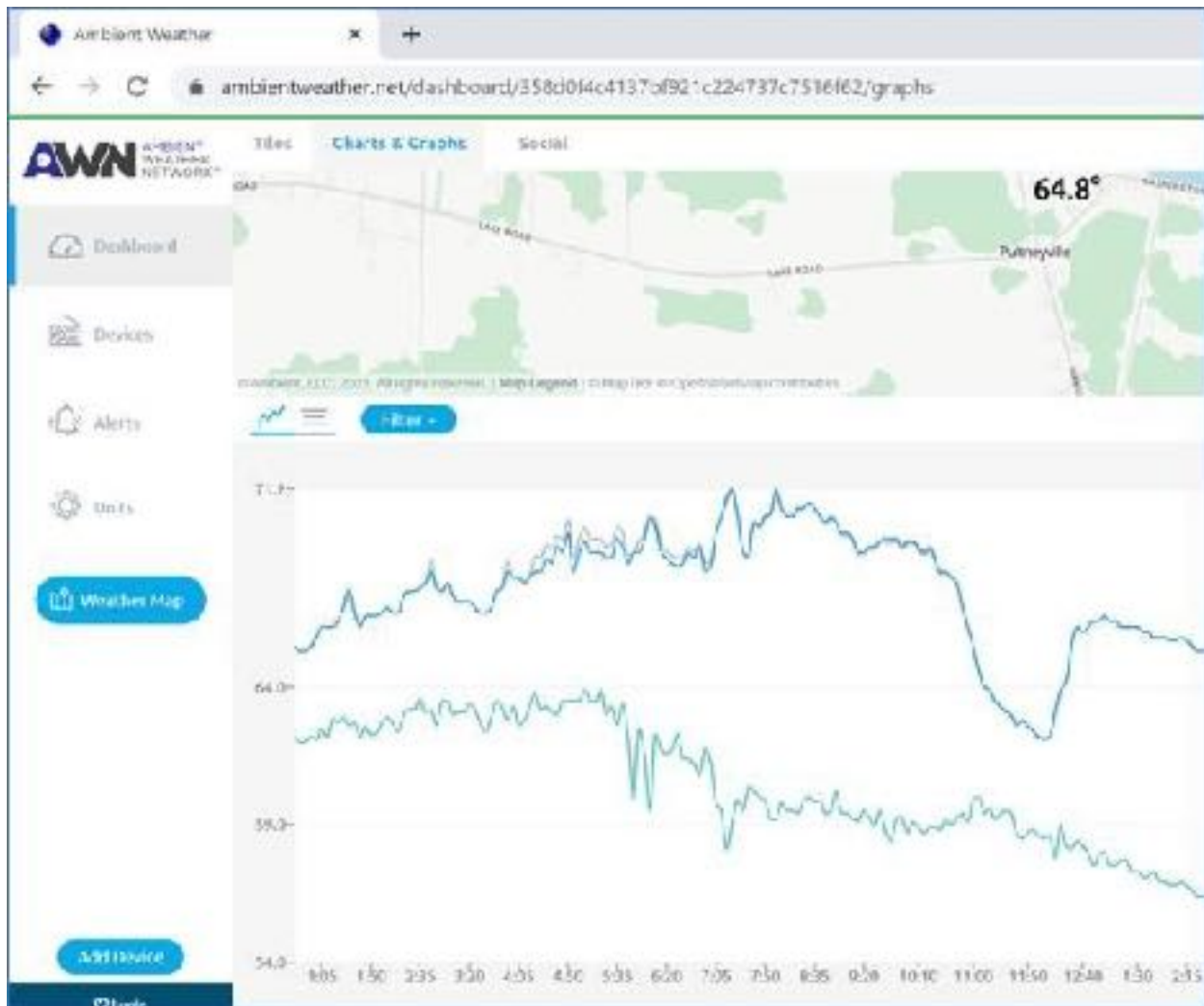


5. Click on **View Dashboard**
