Get Winter Ready....

To all drysail members with boats stored or to be stored on the lawn: due to the expected high volume of cars parked on the lawn during Fall clean-up please move your boats into your winter storage space **before or after** October 21st.. but **NOT during** Fall clean-up.

To Members in sheds 2 and 3: plastic tarps were put in place to cover boats and gear from debris and paint when the shed roofs were painted. When you go into sheds 2 and 3 please pull this plastic off and out. Please discard this plastic in our "blue frog" formerly known as a dumpster.

Dockwall members: please prepare to pull out your monohull sailboats and store for the winter before the end of October as the boat ramp repair will start sometime around the end of October, beginning of November.

To Members with catamarans: Please secure your boats as previously recommended in the September Mainsheet.

FYI...Restrooms: Every winter season when the water gets turned off and drained in the bathrooms, the locks are changed to prevent access. The restrooms remain closed until Spring clean-up when we re-open for the next season. This process usually starts during the 1st or 2nd week in November.

PMI was granted a DEC permit for fixing the boat ramp dock wall. Contractor has been notified and we are checking the water levels. So far the end of October or first weeks of November is scheduled for the dig. DEC requires a land attack and we are not allowed to put machinery in the water, just the bucket. Materials will arrive about a week or so before the repair. Material that is excavated needs to stay on the property, and will be used

to fill in low spots around the club, in the cat island and South-West area where the mono hauls are stored.

What needs to happen and we will need help:

Move the sail patrol shed,

Take apart the dock where the sail patrol boat is located.

After the repair; put everything back,

....hopefully before the snow flies.

Check your eMail for Jib sheets, for work details..

Yellow house update, PMI was informed with an updated print of an easement to the driveway where we will be required to move the entrance gate west of its location, down the hill. We are waiting for the final word on how far down the driveway ramp we will need to move the gate. A total reconfiguring of the driveway will be needed. Requirements are for a flat spot on the driveway so a person stepping out of a vehicle to open the gate will not get hurt by rolling down the hill. We also need to make sure cars with trailers can egress the club and to also make sure the trash truck can negotiate the driveway. Design / ideas help would be welcome. Note; driveway reconfiguration / fence install will be completed by a contractor(s)/ PMI is not incurring any expense for this work.

Some other matters, Fall clean up October 21, 2023, water shut off in November (before the freeze sets in) PMI will be a carry in carry out trash after October 27, 2023 the dumpster will be locked. It looks like the lake water has turned over with the water temperature of about 44 degrees, sadly the season is sailing away, but soon the winds will change and we will be back.
