Welcome Members Spring is right around the corner. Water update 2024, As you are aware the Yellow House has sold. So some history about drinking / bathing water delivered to the club. We are 'Tee-d' off the Yellow house's water line. We shared a common waterline and meter. Now with the sale of the yellow house we are required to have our own water tap and meter. So until this happens we can still use the existing setup... Well, yes that would have worked for a little

while, but this winter the water line split in the yellow house before the shut off valve, requiring the curb stop valve to be shut off. We were engaged with the Trust earlier this year about our dilemma and they stepped up and paid the water tap for the club. I met with the Town of Williamson Water Department and a Contractor who will install our water service to the club from the curb stop valve. But as always we do have some problems, one the location on the curve road, two, the water main under the road is owned by the Town of Williamson (good news) but the road is owned by Wayne County and they will not issue a permit to dig up the road until April 2024. This is due to the snow plowing season. I was informed by the Town Water Department that they have multiple leaks in the system that need attention first, that are also located under Wayne

County roads. So some good news: We asked and were granted an easement on the sale of the yellow house to run our water line across the yellow house's property, this will help immensely with the install of our water line and lower install cost. We have on site a porta-potty which we will keep until we have water. Keep an eye to the Main sheet and Jib sheet for updates on the "water line saga at PMI"
