Spring is here and Summer is just around the corner. We have an issue about lack of water at the club. Back story: Since the sale of the Yellow house, we ran into a problem with a major water line break this Winter. Water was turned off at the curb stop valve by the Williamson Water Department. We are required and will be installing a new dedicated water line. Fees have been paid and contracts signed. But I have no idea when the install will happen

due to seasonal requirements, acquiring permits, dealing with different agencies, our contractor's availability and the scheduling of the Yellow house's construction schedule. We do have a stop gap method to bring a temporary water line into the club. That said we should have water, cross your fingers, but at reduced pressure. The hot water tanks will be offline at this time. Thanks to the Buehlers (Charlotte and Gary) for their assistance in giving us temporary water hookup during our outage.

We still have the dock wall repair to complete and the dock deck needs to be installed. We will need help on this little project. I reached out to Kathy Fedick (PYC, Vice-Commodore) for use of their maintenance barge to have a secured platform while working on the water side of the dock structure. We are making a concrete plate to close up the 'gap'. This plate will be cast on the pavilion floor so please watch your step; it will need to cure for 28 days.

We are looking for some help to build a new storage room in the men's bathroom to store PMI's supplies. Spring cleanup is coming soon, when you arrive at the club, you will notice the front entrance will look a bit different. We found two trees on the property by the entrance that were hollow and needed to be removed for safety reasons.

Note the Wifi will be back online around May 26, 2024. Whoever has the weather station please bring it back and install it at the spring cleanup. We have a bunch of little projects to complete, more to follow on that. Looking forward to seeing everyone and welcome back to PMI.

Your 2024 Membership Card

Please note: All locks will be changed immediately after Spring Clean-up on May 4th. You will not have access to the club using the previous year's lock combinations if you have not picked up your new membership card during spring clean up.

The **membership card** will have the newly assigned combinations to access:

- The main gate, pedestrian gate, both restrooms and the boat ramp,
- The waterfront pavilion door,
- restroom supply closet,
- the cat-wheel and dolly shed,
- the patrol shed,
- And your storage shed assignment(s).
