Volunteer Opportunity: Beachgrass Maintenance

If you would like to fulfill your volunteer requirement at PMI while beautifying the property, here's a volunteer activity for you. We're trimming back 2 rows of beach grass growing southward on the sand mounds. To do this, we are removing plants marked accordingly. To help, simply go to the marked area, bring or use a shovel from Shed 5, then lift and loosen roots under beach grass plants, and they will pull out easily. Bring plants to the dumpster. Please stay within the marked area. Don't forget to log in your hours in the green folder marked GROUNDSKEEPING adjacent to the area where the Duty Officer Binder is kept.
