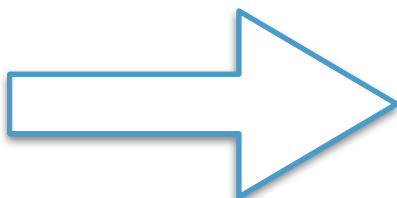
## Quartermaster, Charlotte Buehler
