Hi fellow PMI members,
I hope that everyone is enjoying the recent extended summer-like weather! I'm certain that many are spending this "bonus" time at the club, as we know cool temperatures will arrive soon.

As I mentioned in last month's Main Sheet, I am focusing most of my time on coordinating the activities to reconfigure the electrical service and entry/exit security related to the construction of the new house near the northeast corner of club property. Allow me to share the status of these activities:

Electrical service relocation and distribution upgrades are nearly complete. A new telephone pole has been installed and is now located on club property (legacy telephone pole is located on the property of the new house). In addition, a new electrical distribution pedestal has been erected near the new pole and is functional via a temporary connection through the present supply. In the beginning of October, RGE will permanently connect PMI to their distribution system. Many hours of labor and electrical update have been invested and please contact me if you are interested in the details. Many thanks go out to Rich Seyfried, the FSRFF team, Bryant Dunham, Tom Hooker, Charles Rohn and many other contributors.



The other major activity is updates to the entrance, since we share the driveway with the new house. As such, we are relocating the entrance gate away from the shared driveway area near the road, adding new fencing to prohibit entrance to unauthorized vehicles, and improving the quality and grade of the entrance roadway. With the aid of members of the board, a new entrance configuration has been selected. I'm meeting and gathering quotes from multiple fencing, excavation, utility location providers which will be reviewed with the board and ultimately the trustees. We hope that most of the updates will be completed in October or early November. Let me know if you have any questions regarding these updates.

One more very important update is Linda Rohlfing has volunteered to lead the Maintenance and Repair Committee. I'm very excited to have her on board and I'm certain she will be in touch with the committee members as there is much to do!

The winds of autumn are upon us and the Pultneyville Mariner

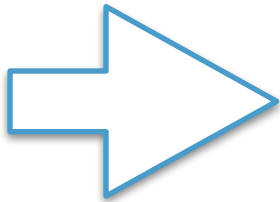
Crew will come together on **Saturday, October 18** to batten down the hatches for winter.
